Current Meter Installation Prices

Bartonville WSC currently installs a 5/8" X 3/4" water meter rated at 25 gallons per minute flow. This is considered a standard residential size meter by the water utility industry.

The current charge for this meter is: *\$7,581.00

Broken down as:

\$7,036.00	Capital Improvement or Capital Expansion Fee, which pays for improvements that have been made to the BWSC system. Example: Elevated Water Tower, Miles of New Water Mains, etc. (See www.bartonvillewater.com for a complete capital projects history.)
\$150.00	Membership Fee
\$395.00	Labor and materials for Meter Installation
*\$7,581.00	Total

*Those installations requiring a road bore will be more expensive due to the labor and special equipment needed to underbore a road, street, etc. This charge will be approximately \$700.

BWSC can also provide a 1" meter for those residential customers requesting greater water flows. A 1" meter is rated at 70 gallons per minute water flow.

The current charge for a 1" water meter is: \$12,385.12

Broken down as:

\$11,750.12	Capital Improvement or Capital Expansion Fee, which pays for improvements that have been made to the BWSC system. Example: Elevated Water Tower, Miles of New Water Mains, etc. (See www.bartonvillewater.com for a complete capital projects history.)
\$150.00	Membership Fee
\$485.00	Labor and materials for Meter Installation
\$12,385.12	Total
